**CALL FOR BIDS**

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Renton, at the City Clerk's Office located on the 7th floor of Renton City Hall, until 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 7, 2016, and will then be opened and publicly read in conference room #511, located on the 5th floor, Renton City Hall. Subcontractor list and written confirmation forms signed by DBE subcontractors listed on the DBE Utilization form will be received until 3:00 PM (1 hour after bids due) that same date. Renton City Hall is located at 1055 South Grady Way, Renton WA 98057.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit (certified check or surety bond) in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Renton.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding.

A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) mandatory goal of 19% has been established for this project.

The improvement for which bids will be received is described below:

Removal of curb, gutter, sidewalk, and asphalt pavement; construction of curbed median islands with landscaping and irrigation; installation of electrical conduit and solar radar speed feedback signs; asphalt grinding, installation of asphalt for pavement repair and overlay, curb ramps, utility adjustments, and channelization of Duvall Ave NE.
