PARKS LABORER SEASONAL

Wages: \$10 – \$12 DOE
Hours Per Week: Up to 40

SUMMARY:

- » Perform general grounds clean up and maintenance.
- » Prepare parks for daily use, including, but not limited to, picking up and disposing of trash and garbage, and cleaning picnic areas, tables, and BBQ's.
- » Performs routine ball field work, including, but not limited to, filling in home plates and pitching mounds, removing rain water from fields, screening fields, watering ball fields, lining ball fields, placing bases at proper distances for games or practices, and removing bases at end of games.
- » Aides in sprinkler system repair, including, but not limited to, checking control for accurate settings, checking for proper head rotation, assisting in digging trenches for repairs, assisting in repairs.
- » Operate sod cutters, pruners, rotary hand mowers, backpack blowers, edgers, mowers, trucks, miscellaneous manual and power hand tools; wash and clean equipment.
- » Supervision and operation of the boat launch at Gene Coulon Park to help boat patrons, traffic control in boat launch area, enforcement of park rules and assist lifeguards during an emergency.
- » May work a variety of shift schedules and holidays.

PARKS LABORER Temp (PERS eligible)

Wages: \$12–\$14 DOE
Hours Per Week: Up to 40

SUMMARY:

- » In addition to the responsibilities listed for our seasonal staff, PERS staff may also be involved with:
- » Operation of turf and field maintenance equipment including riding mowers and ballfield tractors/machines.
- » Grounds maintenance of a specific site.

PART-TIME CUSTODIAN

Henry Moses Aquatic Center (2)

Wages: \$12–\$14/hr
Hours Per Week: 16–24

SUMMARY: Maintains cleanliness of locker rooms and restrooms, restocks paper and soap products, unlocks and locks facility doors for security, and various other custodial and maintenance functions.

FARMERS MARKET LABORER (2)

Wages: \$10–\$15 / hr DOE
Hours Per Week: 10–15

MUST be available to work every market: Tuesdays, June–September.

SUMMARY: Unloading, set-up and tear-down of tents, tables, chairs, and other miscellaneous equipment for the farmers market each week. Clean up, i.e. clearing and cleaning tables and chairs, emptying trash cans, picking up trash, and checking restrooms for cleanliness/supplies. Must have excellent customer service skills and work cooperatively with others using tact, patience and courtesy. May also provide direction for volunteers and staff as needed. Other duties as assigned. This position will drive a City of Renton truck and trailer. Must be 18 years of age, valid WA Driver's license.

NEIGHBORHOOD PROGRAM LABORER (2)

Wages: \$12–\$15 / hr DOE
Hours Per Week: 20

SUMMARY: Operate a City vehicle and transport a mobile barbecue and/or equipment trailer to different neighborhoods throughout the City of Renton. Assist in maintaining an inventory of picnic supplies, in addition to picking up supplies from food vendors. Must be 21 years or older and have a valid WA State Driver's license.

YOUTH VOLUNTEERS, AGES 14–18 are needed to help with recreation activities that will be provided at the Summer Lunch Program sites that are coordinated with the Renton School District. The Summer Lunch Program is free to anyone under the age of 18 and it will start Monday, June 27 and ends on Friday, August 19. Volunteers need to be enthusiastic, energetic and like to interact with younger children. Shifts are flexible and locations will be finalized in May.
